Below are a few notes regarding this rental home:

Garbage

- The garbage dumpster is located at the top of the driveway to the Equestrian Center on the east side. Pick up is on Friday mornings. Please keep dumpster lid closed so the wild critters don't have a free for all!
- Use the blue recycle bags for glass, tin, plastic and aluminum.
- Fish guts should be wrapped in newspaper and placed in a plastic bag prior to putting in the dumpster.

Pets

- **Please clean up after your pets and keep the lawn free of dog doo for our next guests and for our maintenance crew!**
- **If your pet likes to visit the neighbors, please keep it on a leash when outside. Of course, don't let your pet outside by itself!**

Generator

- Station does have a generator large enough to power most everything in the house, but please be judicious in your electrical use when the generator is running due to a power outage.

Campfire

- The fire pit is located in the yard between the house and the lake close to the retaining wall.
- Please only use the firewood provided along the retaining wall! The firewood stacked by the cement garage doesn't belong to us!

Boats

- The rowboats are available for your use as are the silver and green canoes and paddleboat.
- Life vests are required for each passenger and are available when you check in.
- There is a 22' fishing barge pontoon available for rent by the day or by the week.

Smoking

- This is a NON-SMOKING home. If you choose to smoke outside, please dispose of your cigarette butts in the "butt bins" located at the front and back of the home. Please do not just throw them on the ground!

Grill

- We provide 2 charcoal grills for your use, 1 up by the kitchen area and 1 near the fire pit. Please dispose of used charcoal in metal containers provided.

Neighbors

- In order to make everyone's vacation more enjoyable, we ask that you please respect the neighbors by keeping noise to a minimum after 10 p.m. and before 9 a.m.
- If you use a jet ski, please be respectful of other boaters.

Reservations

- Check in is at 2 p.m. and check out is at 9 a.m.
- We require a credit card number on file.
- Ping pong paddles and balls as well as pool cues and balls will be issued upon check in should you want them.
- Please leave the keys on the table and the door unlocked when you leave. If you checked out other equipment (life jackets, pool & ping pong table equipment or rental items), please leave these things in the hallway to the garage.
